General Information: This shoot is limited to the first 45 shooters who pre-register. No deposit is required. Preference will be given to 5 Gun Shooters. NSSA and MSSA Daily Fees: They are included in the entry fees.

Rules and Regulations: This shoot is authorized and registered with the MSSA & NSSA. All rules and regulations will be strictly observed. AAA and AA classified shooters will compete together in AA class.

Liability: Shooters and guests shall hold The Springfield Rod and Gun Club, and it's agents harmless for any loss or injury. Entry or participation in this tournament shall be deemed as agreeing to this provision.

Classification: Classifications will be based on current rules and regulations of the NSSA. HOA and HAA classification will be based upon a shooters FOUR-GUN average as of the last reclassification. The shooter must present a current classification card at registration with all average scores calculated. It is the shooter's responsibility to verify current classification prior to departing registration area.

Ties: All ties for championships will be shot off. All will be shot off with doubles on stations 3, 4, and 5, miss and out by station.

Program Changes: Shoot management reserves the right to make changes in this program without notification, recourse, or protest. Shoot management additionally reserves the right to refuse entry to any contestant, or cause the withdrawal of any contestant, who annoys, endangers, or interferes with the normal operation of this shoot.

Food and Beverages: Food and Beverages will be available for lunch on Saturday and Sunday at no cost to the shooter and their guest. The Club will host a steak dinner on Saturday after the shootoffs at no additional cost to the shooter and their guest.

Practice Rounds and Ammunition: Practice rounds may be shot as long as fields are available. Cost of practice rounds is \$4.00. Hand loads are permitted per NSSA rules and regulations. Proof and shoot-off shells are the responsibility of the shooter.

Chief Referee and Protest Committee: Bill Wayne will be the Chief Referee. The members of the Protest Committee are Bud Wood, Steve Krebs and Bill Wayne.

Withdrawals: Refunds will be made only for withdrawals due to emergency. The protest committee will make the final determination regarding refunds.

Squading: Five-Person squads will be used. Squads will start promptly. Per NSSA Rule II-A-4, squads will proceed without tardy shooters. An attempt will be made to re-squaded tardy shooters, otherwise they will forfeit.
